This document provides an overview of the activity of The Basement Information Centre and the resources that are available for those seeking guidance on basements and those interested in becoming a member.

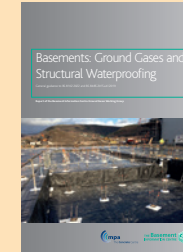
## What we do
